

## Now you can "Drop & Donate" to the Saskatchewan Genealogical Society (SGS)

Funds from this province-wide initiative will help support genealogy and family history presentations and events at the provincial-level, as well as **support branch events**.

## Have you been hoarding your refundable recyclables waiting for the line-ups to go down at SARCAN?

Now you can beat the line-up and donate your deposit refunds to SGS through SARCAN's Drop & Go program.

Simply visit your local SARCAN depot and log in on the Drop and GO terminal using the phase **SK Genealogy**. Once you have logged in, print off the tags for the number of bags or boxes you have to donate, put one label on each bag and box, and leave your order in the designated Drop and Go area in the depot.

Your containers will be counted and your deposit refunds will be donated to the Saskatchewan Genealogical Society.

Please note that the Society will not be listed as one of the available charities on the SARCAN website as their policy is to list only those organizations that match their vision and mandate, but be assured you can donate your refund to the Saskatchewan Genealogical Society at any one of the SARCAN locations in the province.



Thank you for your support. Here's a few tips to make your donation count:

- Containers must not contain garbage.
- The caps must be removed from all beverage containers. No refunds will be given for containers with caps on.
- Submissions must not contain anything other than the recyclable materials accepted at that specific drop off site.
- Submissions must not include any broken containers or other dangerous or hazardous materials.
- All beverage containers must be purchased in the Province of Saskatchewan.
- You must properly affix the bar code labels to each of your donated bags or boxes.

You can donate your refunds to SGS at any of the 72 SARCAN locations in the province using the group phrase, **SK Genealogy.** 

PLEASE NOTE: Unfortunately, the phrase "SGS" was already in use, so be sure to use the correct phrase. If you use the phrase, SGS, you will be donating to different organization.
